

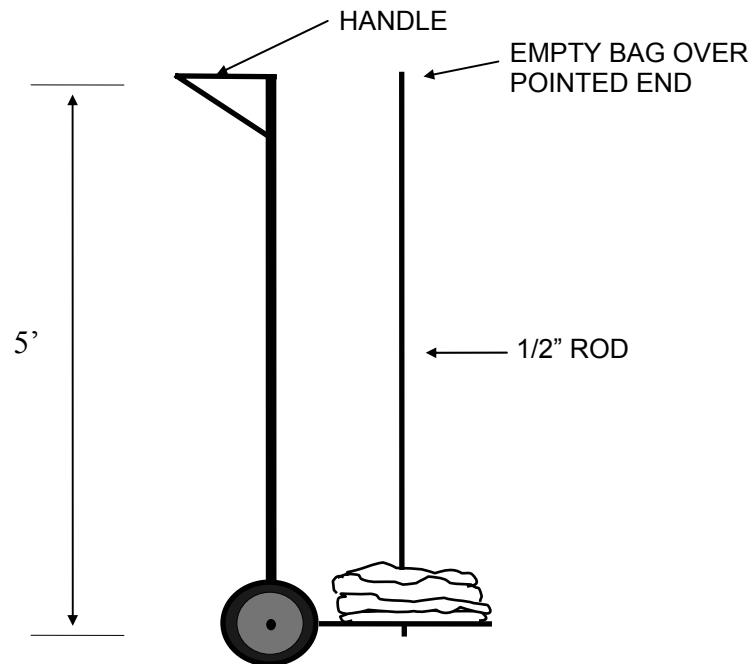


## TECH NICKEL TIPS

### SPIKE YOUR USED BAGS AND KEEP YOUR FEED ROOM CLEAN

Empty pre-mix and concentrate bags can clutter up a feed room, so Mike Sodemans of Forest, Ontario, designed a simple solution. He made a simple bagger frame with a five-foot spike of 1/2" rod welded to it. Whenever he has an empty bag he just stabs it onto the spike. He says he can stab fifty bags onto the spike before he has to wheel his bagger to his disposal area.

Sodemans won a prize in the Ontario Pork Congress "Innovation" competition with this idea.
