



SIGA and VIDO Indigenous One Health Fellowship & Career Start Program

The SIGA & VIDO Indigenous One Health Fellowship & Career Start Program provides Indigenous students with financial support, paid summer placements, and a guaranteed job after graduation. The program is designed to reduce financial barriers and launch long-term careers in science, research, technology, animal health, and One Health fields.

What you receive

- Financial support (see Funding Structure below).
- Paid summer employment with VIDO during your studies.
- Guaranteed employment with VIDO after graduation for a period equal to the years funded (return-in-service).

What you commit to

- Remaining enrolled full-time in an approved program and maintaining satisfactory academic progress.
- Completing required summer work terms at VIDO each year you are funded.
- Fulfilling the postgraduation return-in-service commitment at VIDO.

Funding Structure

- The first \$5,000 is a one-time fellowship with no repayment requirement.
- The remaining funds provide up to \$10,000 per academic year toward tuition as a forgivable student loan which is forgiven upon meeting all program conditions (see below).

Payment method (tuition support)

- Tuition support is issued by direct payment to the institution upon submission of proof of enrollment, per term timelines listed below.

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply if you:

- Self-identify as First Nations, Métis, or Inuit.
- Are enrolled full-time in a postsecondary diploma or degree program relevant to science, technology, or research (e.g., Biotechnology; Chemical/Biological Laboratory Technology; Animal Health Technology; Veterinary Technician/Medicine; Microbiology; Molecular Biology; Immunology; Biomanufacturing).
- Are currently in Year 1, 2, or 3 of your program.



How to Apply

2. Attach your current résumé (with three references—see details below).
3. Attach supporting documents (see checklist).

Terms & Conditions

1. **Program purpose:** The program supports education and employment in science, technology, and/or research careers connected to One Health.
2. **Program components:** The program combines a fellowship (non-repayable) and a forgivable tuition loan, plus paid summer employment and post-graduation employment at VIDO.
3. **Approved programs/institutions:** “Approved” means a post-secondary program and institution approved by VIDO.
4. **Academic status.** You must remain in full-time studies in an approved program. You may change disciplines or schools if you remain full-time in an approved program and keep your original graduation date unchanged.
5. **Summer employment:** You must complete summer employment with VIDO from May 1 to August 15 each funded year. Summer employment may not be declined. Wages are paid at the base salary of the position you are training for.
6. **Employment requirements:** You must meet standard employment requirements for VIDO staff (e.g., criminal record check).
7. **Funding:** The program is a combination fellowship, forgivable loan and employment program.
 - a. **Fellowship:** Not repayable, one-time \$5,000;
 - b. **Forgivable tuition loan:** Up to \$10,000 per academic year, forgiven when you: (1) remain enrolled full-time in an approved program; (2) successfully complete your diploma/degree; (3) complete required VIDO summer employment each year; and (4) fulfill your postgraduation return-in-service commitment. If any condition is not met, all or part of the loan may become repayable as outlined in the student agreement.
8. **Payment & documentation.**
 - a. Provide proof of enrollment and transcripts each term before payment.
 - b. Provide proof of enrollment for tuition and books by end of September (Fall) and end of January (Winter) for payment processing.

9. **Conduct:** Serious workplace misconduct may result in termination for cause, forfeiture of remaining funds, repayment of advanced funds, and loss of guaranteed employment upon graduation.
10. **Selection decisions:** VIDO has final and binding discretion regarding eligibility, awards, and administration of the program.
11. **Taxes:** You are responsible for any tax implications arising from this program.
12. **Contractual agreement:** Award recipients must sign a student agreement with VIDO detailing funding, summer employment, and return-in-service obligations.
